History of Audubon Place

Considered the most illustrious residential park in New Orleans, Audubon Place is a private street located adjacent to Tulane University and directly across Saint Charles Avenue from Audubon Park. Developed in the 1890s by George Blackwelder, Audubon Place was envisioned as a millionaires' enclave containing the finest residences to be found in New Orleans. The majestic Romanesque stone and iron gates which frame the entrance to Audubon Place were designed in 1894 by architect Thomas Sully.

Today the neighborhood boasts 28 spectacular residences, in styles ranging from Colonial Revival to Romanesque Revival, Queen Anne, Mission, and Renaissance Revival. These distinguished homes were designed by such renowned New Orleans architects as Favrot and Livaudais, Toledano and Wogan, Soulé and MacDonnell, Frank P. Gravely and Company, Emile Weile, Southron Duval, Weiss and Dreyfous, Diboll, Owen and Goldstein, Andry and Bendernagle, and MacKenzie, Goldstein and Biggs.
